

A working list of titles by Peter Skidmore PhD, FRES (1936-2009)

A draft of this working list of titles by Peter Skidmore was initially completed in October 2010. It was posted on the website of the Thorne & Hatfield Moors Conservation Forum, superseding an interim list there. Twenty copies of a paper version were also distributed in October 2010. The present working list has additions/revisions inserted to 18 May 2011. It is made available in the delegate pack for the Peter Skidmore Memorial Survey of Hatfield Moors, 10-11 June 2011, organized by the above Forum. This version also appears on the Forum website, replacing the existing working list.

Several autobiographical/biographical sources on Peter Skidmore appeared during his lifetime, and are given in the working list that follows. Additionally, it is known that Peter appeared in three local press features (*Doncaster Evening Post* 6 October 1980; *Doncaster Star* 17 December 1994, 1 August 1995). The following posthumous tributes and appreciations are published or – in one case – is imminent. In addition, an obituary and bibliography by Colin Johnson is being prepared for publication in the *Entomologist's Monthly Magazine*.

In the working list of titles that follows, 240 dated titles are cited, both published and unpublished. Three undated titles are also given. From this total, six comments are relevant:

1. As a working list, the citations of published items are included under the year given in the publication, which occasionally deviates from the year of actual publication.
2. Where years are missing in the working list, no citations have been traced for those years.
3. All dated items listed are included chronologically as a consolidated bibliography. 'Other titles' is a heading used to embrace a small residue of undated or unfinished material. Notebooks compiled by Peter, and his museum-related correspondence, are excluded here.
4. The so called 'grey literature' has been difficult to compile, and complete accuracy is impossible. In general, such unpublished reports are publicly available to those commissioning them, but are often difficult for the bibliographer and researcher to trace or access.
5. All titles are given in lower case except where otherwise necessary.
6. Work undertaken by Peter, but merely acknowledged in print and not published directly under his name, is not included.
